The parade begins promptly at 6 pm on North Trade Street at the Landrum Fire Department.

Please have your entry at the line-up by 5:30 pm. All entries access at the railroad crossing across from Pierce Grading. You will be given more instruction when you arrive.

Because the parade is an evening event, please consider adding lights to your entry so that bystanders can better see it. Throwing candy from a float or vehicle is a safety risk to children who scramble in the street to retrieve it.

The parade turns left on E. Rutherford, then turns right at O. P. Earle Elementary School, ending at the Landrum Middle School parking lot. If your entry includes walkers, make sure arrangements are made either for pick up there or to return them to your original starting point.

Getting your group together: The Fred's parking lot is recommended for groups meeting to ride on floats. The parking lot at Landrum United Methodist Church, 227 N. Howard Avenue, is also available for parents bringing students to participate in the parade. Walking groups should plan to assemble here and arrive together for the parade. Safety personnel will help with safe crossing on N. Howard (Highway 176).

Make plans to stay downtown for the Christmas Stroll which follows.
