



**Work Session Minutes
Landrum City Council
Tuesday, August 10, 2021**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS, SECTION 30-4-80, THE TIME, DATE AND LOCATION OF THE MEETING WAS POSTED AT CITY HALL, ON THE CITY WEBSITE AND THE CITY FACEBOOK PAGE, THE MEDIA WAS DULY NOTIFIED.

1. Continued discussion of contribution requests.
 - a) Landrum High School Athletic Booster Club
The booster club will need to submit in writing a request for funds and a brief description as to what the funds would be used for. In the past, the donation was given out of the hospitality tax fund and used for end of season meals for the various sports teams, in return the school advertised for the City at sporting events.
 - b) Feed the Foothills: Carolina Foothills Chamber of Commerce/ Operation Hope. The Council discussed the request and decided to add this item to the agenda in the regular meeting, so they could act on it tonight.
2. Update on proposed Landrum Senior Citizen Building Acquisition
City Administrator gave the Mayor and Council an update on the proposed Senior Citizen Building. The building will require a new roof, HVAC system and water proofing in the basement area and an improved water drainage system. An August 31, 2021, closing is planned, the City will pay \$150,000 for the building and the owner will turn around and donate \$50,000 back to the City as a donation.
3. Update on American Rescue Plan funding
The City still has not received the Federal Covid Relief funds, 7 states still haven't received their funds yet, and South Carolina is one of those states. The State still has not requested the funds from the federal government.
