Re: **WORK SESSION ITEM 2 – Municipal Code 2023 Update**

The Landrum Municipal Code was adopted on September 1, 2000. Although many ordinances have been passed since 2000, the municipal code document has not been revised since that time.

The document has been prepared by the City Attorney and his staff with input from the Mayor, the Chief of Police Coffin, City Clerk Rita Bruce and me. The most significant changes in this document reflect the following:

- a. Eliminated dog licensing (Chapter 3) and updating the animal code already adopted by the City Council in 2022;
- b. Eliminated the Beautification committee (Chapter 4);
- c. Made consistent with the most recent state requirements for municipal court (Chapter 7) and police (Chapter 14);
- d. Eliminated the Fire Department Chapter 9;
- e. Eliminated the Utilities Chapter 17 for water and sewer services; and
- f. Building Codes (Chapter 5) has been updated with the recent adoption of the new building and property maintenance codes by the City Council in June 2023.

Attached is a copy for your review and comment is the revised Municipal Code. This code will be for the August City Council meeting for adoption. Staff from the city attorney's office will be available at the work session on July 11 by telephone to answer any questions.
